### ***PRAY THAT:***

**I. Every Elder be a Teacher**-1 Tim. 3:2; 5:17

**Titus 1:9** He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.

**Eph. 4:11-12** And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

**III. The Church Recognize and Expose False Teaching**

**Acts 20:29-30** I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them.

**IV. Every Believer Be Eager to Listen to and Obey the Word of God** -2 Tim. 3:14-17; Acts 20:32; Psalm 1:2,3; Matt. 7:24,25
