I. What Worship is Not

A. Worship of men/women/angels - Rev. 19:10; 22:8
Acts 10:25-26 When Peter entered, Cornelius met him and fell down at his feet and worshiped him. But Peter lifted him up, saying, "Stand up; I too am a man."

B. False worship

-of Christ Matt. 15:8-9 This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.

-of images Ex. 20:4-5 You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them,

A. Illustration Matt.4:10 Then Jesus said to him, "Be gone, Satan! For it is written, "You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve."

B. Examples of worship -Mt. 2:11; Rev. 4:10; 7:11; 11:16; 19:4
Rom. 12:1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

Rev. 5:14 And the four living creatures said, "Amen!" and the elders fell down and worshiped.

-Only one God -Mt. 4:10; Heb. 1:6; Jn. 4:20-24; Isa. 40; Ex. 20
Deut. 6:4-5 Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

D. Because He Judges -Rev.15:4

Rev. 14:7 And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

Response in Worship

A. With Humility -Job 1:20,21; Matt. 9:18; Isaiah 6; Rev. 1 Micah 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

B. In the Spirit -John 4:24

Phil 3:3 For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh

C. Faith and Worship -John 11:21

John 9:38 He said, "Lord, I believe," and he worshiped him.

D. Repentance and Worship

1 Corinthians 14:24-25 But if all prophesy, and an unbeliever or outsider enters, he is convicted by all, he is called to account by all, the secrets of his heart are disclosed, and so, falling on his face, he will worship God and declare that God is really among you.
